RE: Addressing WUSA's slow reimbursement process

ISSUE: Implementing interest on unpaid cheque requests to encourage WUSA to reimburse students in a timely manner.

DETAILS:

Whereas WUSA's reimbursement process for clubs and societies is unacceptably slow, in some cases leaving students out hundreds or even thousands of dollars for months.

Whereas WUSA's slow reimbursement process discourages students from getting involved in clubs and societies as many students are on a limited budget.

Whereas WUSA's slow reimbursement process is unacceptable to students, especially low income students.

RECOMMENDATION(S) / DRAFT MOTION(S):

BE IT RESOLVED THAT the Assembly implements interest on unpaid cheque requests, whereby if WUSA fails to prepare and have ready a cheque for a valid cheque request within two calendar weeks of receiving it, the amount requested compounds biweekly at a rate of 10%. Thereby, WUSA is incentivized to make core operations, such as reimbursement of students, a top priority.
